2007 when Trailhead Lodge's 86 condos opened for sale (studios were priced from \$440,000; and one 2-bedroom-plus-den was \$1,375 million). Fast-forward to this week when Steamboat opens its legendary mountain (Nov. 21) and you'll see Wildhorse Gondola up and operat-ing, with the last 30 of Trailhead Ledge's homes headed for auction at starting bids that are a whisper of their pricing four years back — from as little as \$95,000.
