

Getting his massage across

Dr. Michael Ho hopes you get the massage.

The former Calgary chiropractor has developed a device called Dr. Ho's Muscle Massage Therapy System, an advanced electronic device incorporating electronic components to provide a dozen variable techniques of muscle relaxation.

He believes it can work wonders.

So much so, in fact, that he dedicated about three years of his life and \$1 million of his money into the project, which was launched at a Shopper's Home Health Care show.

"I like to help people so they can do

things in life that they want to do," says Ho, who also practises acupuncture, but is now based in Toronto.

"Maybe patients can't plan a full day because they get migraines.

"This is good (to fight) migraines."

The machine retails for about \$135 and is partially covered by health care, says Dr. Ho.

"The machine will train muscles to stay relaxed."
